The minutes from November 19, 2014 were moved by Dan Murphy to “not read the minutes” and seconded by Walt Piantek because they were posted on the OLMGC web site. Motion passed unanimously

**1st V.P. TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR — Ron Oldhafer**

December Holiday Tournament had 66 players; January’s Four-Man Scramble had 79 players, February’s Two-Man-Niner had 66 players and March’s medal play had 66 players. All tournaments went smooth.

**ASSISTANT TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR — Theo Fallati**

Theo says he has caught up the leader board through February. Fifty percent of players have scored points either in side games or regular pots.

Rich said that because of the new website system, the program posts the scores automatically. Rich says he is involved with scholarship funds in other clubs. Other clubs including Olivas Links are Olivas Links Senior, River Ridge Seniors, Buena Senior.

**TREASURER — Pat Krull**

Pat said there is \$33,580 in the OLMGC bank account, but Morro Bay and the March tournament funds have not been deducted yet.

Ashley said there were only four people at the Wednesday event and that he came in first net.

**PARLIAMENTARIAN — Steve Arnold**

Steve says he and Theo Fallati are going down to a SCGA handicap chairman's meeting. Steve says he has a good handle on the rules of golf. Steve wants to put rules on the website. One such rule discussed was players are not allowed to touch the line of their putts, unless they are removing loose impediments or fixing divots. Steve requested that players should enforce rules violations. There was a question about hole #12. The ball was suspected of being out of bounds down the left side. The player hit a second ball, but the first ball was farther down. It's ok to hit the second shot from the second provisional ball if it is farther back than the first ball, to save time. Theo Fallati asked about a concrete drain near the hazard on #16. Steve says you get relief.

**SCGA CLUB DELEGATE & OLIVAS LINKS LIAISON – Brad Zlomke**

Brad reported that he has submitted tournament results to the Ventura County Star. He said course is in decent shape, but is aerating the following week.

**WEBMASTER — Mike Corr**

Mike says he is making minor changes to the web pages. There is not a whole lot going on. There was a question about signing up, and then confirming a player's sign up on line.

**MEMBERSHIP CHAIRMAN --- Dave Stoltz**

Dave said that there were 197 members. He said he went through John Clay's files and thought there were 30 applications that seemed to be missing. I wondered if there was a way to keep track of online and old style.

**SPECIAL EVENTS CHAIRMAN — Ken Davis**

Ken Davis said Morro Bay won again. The low gross was 77. Rancho Santa Maria is set for May 9. The rest of the schedule is on the OLMGC website.

**CLUB PRO – Carl-Van Vallier**

Carl reiterated Brad's report on Aeration, set for March 23-24. He also said the merchandise will offer a price match guarantee with another 10 percent off for club members.

**OLD BUSINESS**

It was announced that the Buena Mens Club is allowing OLMGC members the chance to play in up to two tournaments, either at home or away. Michael Brooks asked about the slope rating at Olivas Links. He said that lots seemed to have changed. There was general discussion about slope rating. Billy Brown thought that the club posts nearly all scores, thus changing handicaps indexes which hurts Team Play and Ventura Cup. Michael Brooks questioned the way they are picking people for the Ventura Cup and it doesn't reflect the good golfers in the club. Billy Brown suggested that Brooks should bring suggestions to the next meeting.
